

1 Simpson vs. Bankofier, et al, above referred to, Petitioner's  
2 predecessor in interest, Joe Bankofier was decreed a water  
3 right with a priority of 1884 for an undetermined number of  
4 acres of land within the following described lands and premises,  
5 to-wit:

14 Tp. 40 S., R. 43, E.W.M.

12 And the Court finds that the Petitioner, Alice D. Bankofier,  
13 as the successor in interest of said Joe Bankofier, should be  
14 declared to be the owner of a water right, with a priority of  
15 1884, to 149.60 miners inches of the waters of said Ten Mile  
16 Creek being a duty of water of three (3) acre feet per acre for  
17 a season of sixty days each year for the irrigation of 148.36  
18 acres of real property described as follows, to-wit:

27 SE $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$  - .09 acres  
28 Section 31,  
29 NE $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$  - 21.80 acres  
30 Section 32,  
31 NW $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$  - 7.58 acres

26 And that the same shall constitute the completion of the  
27 "undetermined" inchoate right decreed to Joe Bankofier by the  
28 Judgment in the case of Simpson vs. Bankofier, et al.

30 That the diversion to ditches of the parties now  
31 in place on the ground may be continued as points of diversion  
32 for said ditches for the irrigation of the land irrigable under
