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**Hydraulic property control on observed groundwater response to development and the
implication for future groundwater management in the Harney Basin, Oregon**

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Jerry Grondin bio:

Jerry is an Oregon registered geologist working as a hydrogeologist in the Groundwater Section at the Oregon Water Resources Department in Salem. This month is his 35th year working for the state, 30 years at Water Resources and 5 years at Environmental Quality, and an additional year working for the International Groundwater Modeling Center. He completed his B.S. Geology at Oregon State University, served in the Peace Corps 3 years, then completed his M.S. Hydrology at University of Arizona. Previous groundwater studies include Mosier, Lower Umatilla, and the Upper Lost River sub-basin in the Klamath Basin. This morning he will present hydraulic property control on groundwater response to development in the recently completed Harney Basin study.
