QUIT CLAIM DEED

WHEREAS, the United States of America has heretofore segregated certain lands within the boundaries of Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District in Deschutes County, Oregon, to be reclaimed under the provisions of the Carey Act; and

WHEREAS, qualified entrymen entered upon the following described lands:

WHEREAS, the entrymen or their assignees on the foregoing lands have not performed fully all the requirements of the Carey Act and therefore certificates of proof have not been issued covering said lands; and

WHEREAS, Deschutes County has heretofore levied taxes against the said premises which were not paid and on account of such non-payment, said premises have heretofore been included in foreclosure proceedings by the county and the property purchased by the County; and

WHEREAS, said property was later purchased by Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District from Deschutes County; and

WHEREAS, it appears that said County had not legal right to levy such taxes against the premises and such sale under foreclosure was and is void and has the effect of clouding the title; and

WHEREAS, Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District has heretofore ordered that a Quit Claim Deed be executed to the State of Oregon to be signed by the Board of Directors conveying any interest the District has in said premises to the State of Oregon.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District does hereby remise, release and forever QUITCLAIM unto the STATE OF OREGON, All its right, title and interest in and to the said premises.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District has caused these presents to be signed by its Board of Directors this 20th day of August, 1936, pursuant to a resolution made and entered by Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District on the 4th day of August, 1936.
